I am an Iranian-Austrian painter and a lyric poet. In Tehran as well as in Vienna I studied painting and graphic arts. Since 1979, I have been working as a free-lance artist and art teacher in Vienna. I am a mother of two grown up children.

When I was fifteen years old, I decided to take this artistic path of life and I have devoted myself to art passionately ever since. It was a difficult to gain a foothold as an artist in a new country. Nevertheless, with a lot of effort but also joy I have experienced various professional highlights.

For me, art is a social, interpersonal and self-determined medium, which I use to communicate with others. The perception of my own needs and desires, as well as of the basic social issues, especially women's interests, determines my commitment as an artist.
